

Explanation

on the use of "conflict minerals"

For the manufacture of various products from the Gonano Dosiertechnik product range, tin and gold are also used, which belong to the group of so-called conflict minerals.

These minerals such as:

- cassiterite (tin ore)
- columbite-tantalite (coltran, tantalum ore)
- gold
- wolframite

could be suspected of being extracted from conflict mines in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or neighboring states.

The profits generated from this are usually used to finance the activities of illegal and criminal groups.

We have therefore asked our relevant suppliers to prove that the metals delivered to GONANO Dosiertechnik are exclusively obtained from harmless mines which are not located in the above-mentioned countries.

Since we have no influence on the origin of the minerals that are used by our suppliers' sub-suppliers, we unfortunately cannot guarantee their sub-suppliers.

The GONANO Dosiertechnik itself does not import any minerals and therefore also no conflict minerals.

We hope that we have answered all related questions with our declaration and ask for your understanding that we cannot fill out customer-specific questionnaires due to lack of time.
